Look for this symbol  on recycled products. It usually means that the product is made of recycled material. But you have to look carefully because sometimes the symbol means the package itself – and not the product’s inside are made from recycled material. Look for words “**Made of Recycled Material**” or “**Post Consumer**” on the product package. Also when collecting beverage containers, whether glass, plastic, or aluminum, always make sure they are clean, this will prevent those pesky ants from invading the containers.
